

MT. VERNON (IL)/WDML-FM/CLASSIC ROCK/MORNING DRIVE HOST

Position: Morning Drive

Shift: currently 5a-9a (weekdays), but considering 6a-10a

106.9 WDML is a Class A FM Classic Rock Icon that serves its community like no other while also playing the very best in Classic Rock! With this rare opening in morning drive also comes an opportunity to locally track other Withers Broadcasting stations--no, not cookie cutter tracking--it's still local radio.

Ideal candidate will have radio friendly voice, confidence and clarity in public speaking, and be comfortable with various types of social interaction (phone, social media, in-person, etc). Must have ease of reading over the air for live commercials, live sponsor reads, endorsements, live station events. Host must be willing to learn and follow formats and should be comfortable with technology and maintain at least an intermediate degree of computer sufficiency and will need to know, or lean, the tools to produce radio advertisements.

During hours surrounding air shift, host will help with daily duties such as voicing and producing commercials for stations, website and social media content (including music news stories, social media posts,) etc.

Host must be flexible for evening and weekend availability during the event of a live broadcast (remote) or other station promotions and events. Host is to be present during his/her show 5 days per week, all year long. On holidays or vacation days, host will be responsible for performing one of the following:

- Arriving at station by start of LIVE air shift.
- Voice tracking (with training) shift prior to being gone
- Finding fill-in for show (with permission from management)

Job duties include (but are not limited to):

- Daily air shift on WDML each weekday with show prep and programming time prior to show
- Voice track daily shift on alternate Withers Broadcasting stations as needed (no more than 2 other shifts daily)
- Voicing, editing and producing commercials
- Assisting with station promotions
- Assisting with station website & social media
- Voice track 2-hour local blues show
- Other duties as assigned by PD, OM, or GM.

A general knowledge of radio broadcasting equipment is preferred, though Host will be trained on all studio equipment and operations. Ability to use audio editing software is also preferred. Host will be thoroughly trained on using automation software.

Optional/Additional Job Duties (could include additional compensation):

- Live appearances
- Running the board for remotes, other events
- Sports play-by-play/commentary
